



Sliding Scale Policy

In order to better serve the patient population of this clinic, Dr. Currey is now accepting payments on a sliding scale. Please note, this is only available for patients who do not work with an insurance company who Dr. Currey currently holds a contract with unless it is being used for services that their insurance has denied payment for.

To access sliding scale pricing, please complete a renewable application that will be held on file for 6 months at a time. The application must be received prior to your visit, and payments will be due at time of service. Only one application necessary per family.

Discount Structure:

Based on Federal Poverty Guidelines (2017)

% Poverty	Discount
100% or below	50% discount
101 -125%	35% discount
126-150%	25% discount
151-175%	15% discount
Above 175%	0% discount
